# President's Report



## **New Academic Programs-New Opportunities**

In partnership with the Foundation, SUNY Ulster continues to identify and respond to the needs of the workforce environment with expanded curricula. Your gifts to the Foundation support these initiatives and, on behalf of the College Board of Trustees, I extend my deep appreciation for your generous gifts this past year.

I would like to take this opportunity to share some of the new degrees and programs now offered at a thriving SUNY Ulster.

SUNY Ulster is recognized as a leader in health and public safety education in the Hudson Valley. As the need for emergency management professionals grows in the area of public safety, the college has extended its degree and certificate training programs to include an Emergency Management Associate in Applied Science Degree and a nationally accredited Paramedic Program Certificate for pre-hospital advanced life support. Additionally, the College now provides a Police Basic Training Program Certificate jointly sponsored by the Ulster County Sheriff's Office and the City of Kingston Police Department that replaces the Police Academy.

As clearly demonstrated by local and world events this past year, the need for education in emergency preparedness for both natural and technological hazards is on the rise. In response to this vital need, SUNY Ulster has engaged in a unique consortium for Emergency Preparedness with SUNY Rockland and SUNY Orange in conjunction with state and local authorities to identify and share curricula through a three-college network. The goal is to unify resources and reduce duplication of course offerings.

In quite a different realm and in step with regional appreciation of the fine and performing arts, SUNY Ulster will be offering an Associate in Arts Degree in Theater Arts beginning Fall 2006. The employment opportunities in various aspects of the theater are enhanced by the proximity of SUNY Ulster to New York City, the world epicenter for theatrical production. A full calendar of cultural programming open to the campus and the community continues to support the appreciation of the arts as a source of enrichment for us all.

Once again, I thank all of our contributors whose thoughtful gifts have enabled the Foundation to assist the college in offering these and other future educational opportunities for the students of SUNY Ulster and for the benefit of the community.

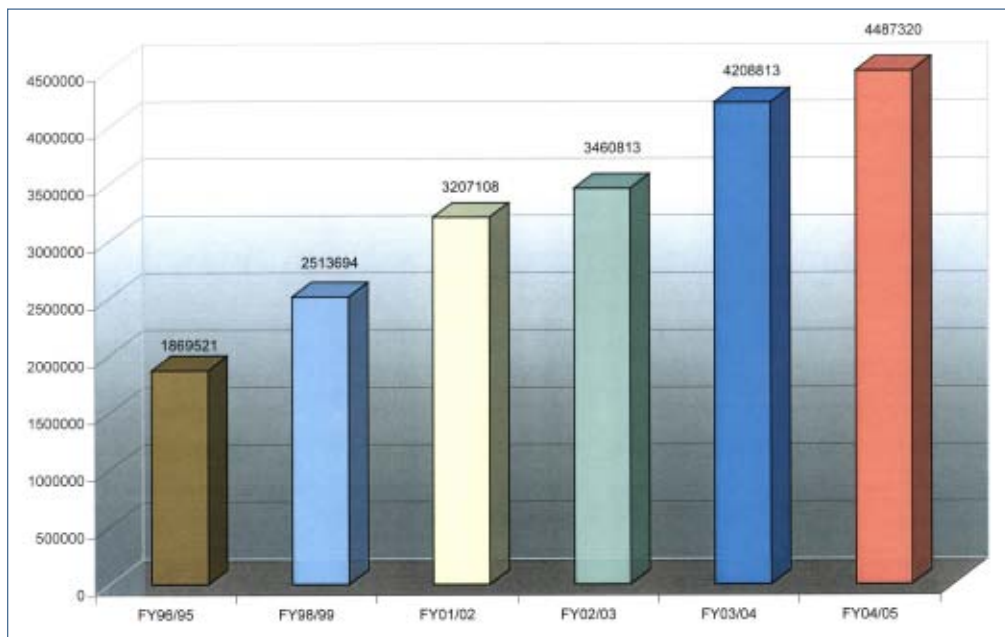

### Investment Account: Total Assets

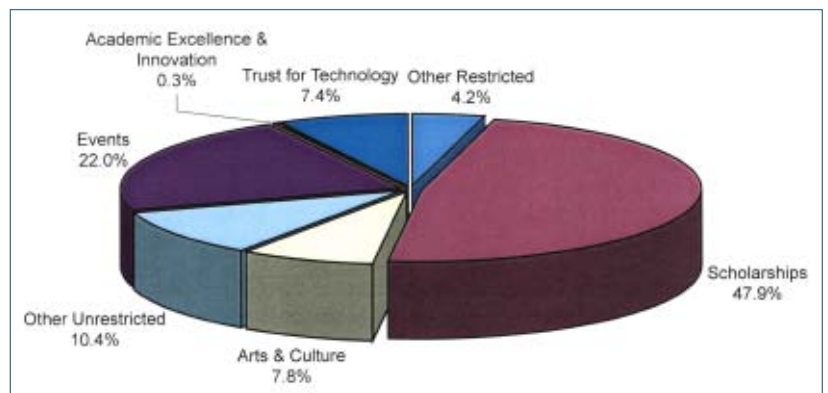

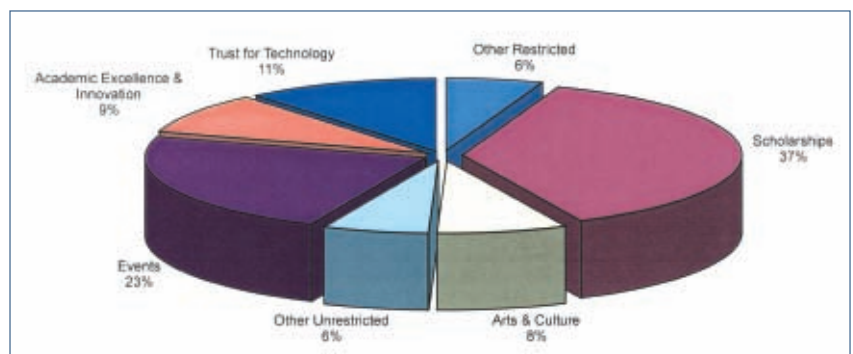

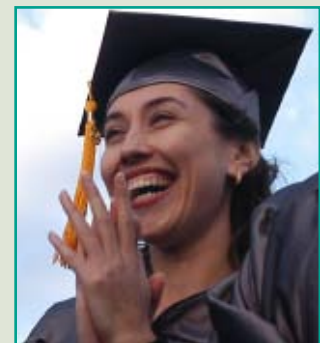
