Dear Nursing, Paramedic or EMT student,

Congratulations on starting your program. In addition to the N.Y. State measles, mumps and rubella requirements for all college students born after 1957, the clinical program areas of nursing, paramedic and EMT have strict hospital requirements. Enclosed you will find the physical exam form you will need to have completed which includes TB testing, varicella (chickenpox) immunity, tetanus date, etc. **Paramedic students will need measles and rubella bloodwork (titers.)** Students should plan to get their physical exams done early since you will not be able to attend the clinical area unless we have your completed form on file.

Students may go to their own doctors or use Emergency One Urgent Care and Diagnostic Center on 40 Hurley Ave. in Kingston for their physicals. They accept many health insurance plans. Call them for information- 845 338-5600.

Students without health insurance should contact us here in Health Services since we may have a doctor coming on campus for physicals. If not Emergency One in Kingston has agreed to a fee of \$55.00 for the medical for students without health insurance (exam only, no vaccines or bloodwork.). You can get TB testing and most vaccines here in College Health Services for free. Reduced fees for bloodwork are available, but you must contact us first to get the bloodwork script for the lab we use in Kingston. Using our services will cost, on average, from \$70.00 - \$100.00. Otherwise the requirements could cost hundreds of dollars.
