BUILD YOUR OWN SKIN-ON-FRAME SOLO/TANDEM CANOE

Guest boatbuilding instructor Hilary Russell, Director of the Berkshire Boat Building School (www.berkshireboatbuildingschool.org) will lead this unique course on building skin-on-frame double paddle canoes. Using kits designed by Russell, you will spend two weekends building your own tandem/solo canoe by constructing a wooden frame and stretching on a polyester "skin." These 28 lb. canoes are strong and can up to 350 pounds. Easily car-topped, they are perfect for casual paddlers and beginning boatbuilders alike. Do not miss the opportunity to build your own beautiful, functional canoe! Optional: On Friday, September 27 and October 5 from 3-6pm the instructor will be setting up.
