### DID YOU KNOW??

New York State has a NEW pathway to obtaining your High School Equivalency Diploma?

This pathway to a diploma allows candidates to substitute passing scores on Regents examinations taken in high school for up to 4 out of the 5 required corresponding TASC™ subtest.

Giving Rural Adults a Study Program (**GRASP**), a Distance Learning Program, offers an alternative learning opportunity for those individuals that cannot attend a traditional classroom setting. Home study students must be 21 years of age or older and willing to study independently for at least six-hours per week. ## HIGH SCHOOL EQUIVALENCY - TASC™ I

This course is a comprehensive review for students wanting to receive their High School Equivalency Diploma. Students will prepare to take the Test Assessing Secondary Completion (TASC™). This test replaced the GED® test for New York State in 2014. The focus of the classes will be on reading/writing, science, social studies, and, mathematics. TASC™ testing is determined by pre-test scores and instructor recommendation. Students may require more than one session of preparation prior to testing. This class will include homework. On April 10, 2018, the New York State Board of Regents approved regulatory changes to provide a fourth pathway to earn a New York State Equivalency (HSE) Diploma.

Individuals who have passed Regents Examinations in English language arts, mathematics, science, and social studies can substitute those passing scores for a maximum of four of the five corresponding Test Assessing Secondary Completion (TASC™) subtests: reading, math, science and social studies.

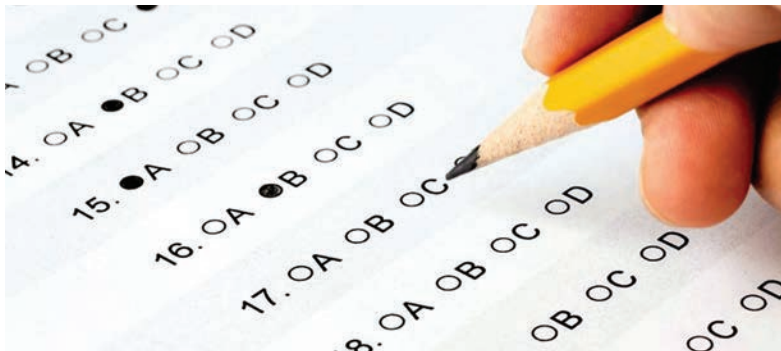
## SAT QUICK PREPARATION
