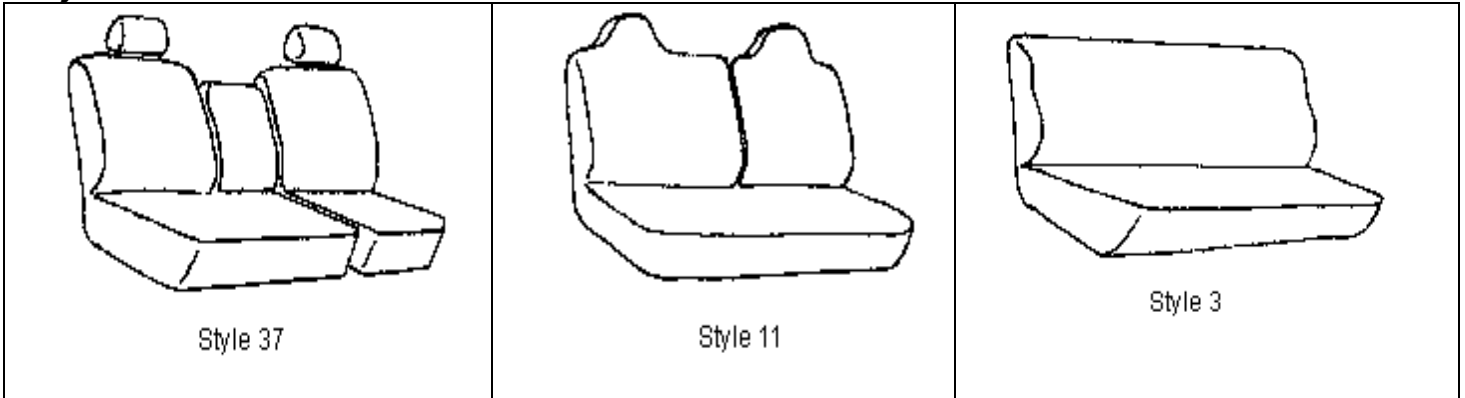
NY State Law: Children up to age 8 must ride in an appropriate child safety or booster seat. The rear seat is safest for all children under 13.
