

## Digital Photography Camp Ages 12-17



This class is designed to enhance the understanding of the basic science and art of photography. The first day of camp is held on campus; the next three days (weather permitting), campers meet at various outdoor locations to use their cameras while learning about composition and what is necessary to get better photos. At the end of each day a suggested voluntary assignment is given to encourage campers to use what they have learned. During the final session on Friday, campers see and critique the images captured during the week in and out of class; the session is designed to highlight the improvements made by each camper. Also on Friday from 11 am to noon parents/family are welcome to see the accomplishments of the campers.

**Requirements:** Please bring a camera with the ability to control aperture and shutter speed each day of camp. A cell phone or tablet camera is not acceptable. Campers must wear comfortable walking shoes for all outdoor sessions; flip-flops are not permitted.

Snack: Please bring water to drink and some non-melting snacks. Please do not bring soda or juice drinks.

**Transportation:** In an effort to provide the safest possible environment for all, each camper must arrive and check-in daily with a parent and be picked up and check-out with a parent present. Each camper must have transportation to and from each location. So that all campers can get the full benefit of the program, it is imperative that they arrive promptly at 8 am every day and are picked up promptly at noon. Campers with valid NYS driver licenses may arrive and depart without their parents' present provided they present a note from their parents giving permission at the first day of camp. Location of shoots (subject to change): Waryas Park Poughkeepsie (Main St. & Hudson River), Vanderbilt Mansion (front of mansion) and Walkway over the Hudson (WEST side parking lot).

**Restrictions:** Campers may not use cell phones or smoke.
