

Photography & Creativity Camp Ages 7-12



Through personal instruction and creatively designed photography projects, campers reflect on and photograph what is meaningful to them, learn how to express themselves visually to aid in the process of self-discovery, and explore how to convey their perceptions of how they see their world. This workshop also teaches the campers how to visually express themselves through the use of framing, light, environment, and, most importantly, experimenting with their unique sense of creativity. Campers are introduced to the basics of digital photography and photo editing software with an emphasis on empowering them to capture their own images.

Educational Leader: Julia Jordan is a Hudson Valley based photographer. She has been teaching and developing photography workshops for children for over 10 years. She personally designs projects to inspire children to creatively observe and express their world.
