TRIO HISTORY

<u>TRiO</u> began with Upward Bound, which emerged out of the Economic Opportunity Act of 1964 in response to the administration's War on Poverty. Talent Search, the second outreach program, was created in 1965. In 1968, Student Support Services became the third in the series of educational opportunity programs. The term "TRiO" was later coined to describe these three federal programs.

<u>Student Support Services</u> projects provide opportunities for academic development, assist students with basic college requirements and motivate students toward the successful completion of their postsecondary education. The goal of Student Support Services is to increase the college retention and graduation rates of its participants.

<u>National TRiO Day</u> was enacted by Congress in 1986 to recognize the achievements of the TRiO Programs and their role in advancing equal opportunity in postsecondary education. The resolution declared that February 26th be dedicated as, "National TRiO Day, a day on which the nation is asked to turn its attention to the needs of disadvantaged young people and adults aspiring to improve their lives... and to the talent which will be wasted if that investment is not made."
