SUNY UISTER SPRING 2015-Credit Classes FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

Where do I get a copy of my class schedule?

Log in to The SUNY Ulster portal available at <u>my.sunyulster.edu</u>. Select the "Student Resources" tab; in the "Registration Tools" channel click on "Class Schedule"; then select Spring 2015 term. Student computers are available in HAS 220, the DEW Library or BRC 204. Students will need to log onto the computers with their <u>My.SUNYUlster.edu</u> user name and password.

Where is wireless access available for using my wireless enabled device?

Wireless is available throughout most of the Stone Ridge Campus and throughout the BRC. Students must be enrolled in credit classes for the semester to access wireless.

How do I get a **book voucher**?

Book Voucher Applications will be available in the Student Development Office, VAN 119 and online at <u>my.sunyulster.edu</u>. Decisions will be sent to your SUNY Ulster email within 3 business days beginning January 6th. Bookstore vouchers are available for students with financial aid grants and/or loans which exceed the cost of tuition and fees. Students eligible to receive refund checks from financial aid during the first week of the semester have the option to accept their refund checks <u>**OR**</u> apply for a Bookstore voucher. Any remaining book voucher credit will be disbursed to students in a refund check at a later date in the semester.

Where and when can I pick up financial aid checks?

Student Accounts - **VAN 204** starting Friday, January 23, 2015 after 10:00am for Federal and State grants only. Additional disbursement information is available at <u>my.sunyulster.edu</u> in the Student Accounts or Financial Aid channel.

Can I still apply for financial aid?

Yes. There are 2 easy steps:

1. Go to <u>www.pin.ed.gov</u> – your pin number is your signature (parent also needs a pin for a dependent student).

2. Go to <u>www.fafsa.gov</u> – complete the online FAFSA using 2013 income information.

Where and when can I get my student ID card and/or parking permit?

Student IDs and Parking Permits can be obtained from the Office of Public Safety, HAS 133.

-Before classes begin, any day between the hours of 9:00 am and 5:00 pm

-After classes begin, between the hours of 9:00 am and 5:00 pm.

**Special arrangements can be made by calling Public Safety at 687-5023. To obtain a Student ID, students must bring a copy of their current schedule and a valid photo ID to the Office of Public Safety. For parking permits, students must have the year, make, model, color and license plate # of their car. Parking permits are not required at the BRC. Students are reminded that they are required to carry their Student ID with them at all times while on campus and present it to any College Official upon their request. In addition, students are reminded that student parking spaces are designated by white lines.

Where do I get Health Insurance certification forms verified?

Registrar's Office-VAN 206 beginning February 10.

How do I get into the online site for my course in ANGEL?

Log in to The SUNY Ulster portal available at <u>my.sunyulster.edu</u>. Click the "ANGEL" icon on the top right corner of the portal.

How can I add and drop courses?

-If you are changing sections only go to Registrar's Office-VAN 206.

(i.e.: ENG 101 section 01 to ENG 101 section 02)

-If you are a non-matriculated student changing classes go to Registrar's Office-VAN 206.

-If you are a matriculated student changing classes you must get an advisor's signature.

(i.e. - COM 105 to HIS 101)

1. See your academic advisor. To find the name of your academic advisor visit <u>my.sunyulster.edu</u> and click on the "Student Resources" tab; go to "Registration Tools" channel; click on "Advisor and Student Information Look-up" link; select "Spring 2015" term then click "Submit"; follow instructions on page to access contact information regarding your advisor.

2. Visit your Academic Department to see if an academic advisor is available.

3. If unsuccessful in locating your academic advisor go to the College Lounge-VAN 203.

Warning! If you are a full-time student receiving financial aid or healthcare benefits based on full-time status and you drop below 12 credits, you may lose your aid/benefits. For financial aid recipients, courses <u>must fulfill</u> requirements of your degree program. Please check with Financial Aid if you have questions-VAN 105.

What are the add/drop/withdrawal dates?

ADD dates:First 4 days of the semester (01/20/15-01/23/15)DROP dates:First 3 weeks of the semester (01/20/15-02/09/15)WITHDRAWAL dates:Weeks 4-10 of the semester (02/10/15-04/07/15) NO RefundsWarning! If you withdraw properly on or before the established withdrawal deadline each semester,
you will receive a "W" grade for the course. If you fail to formally withdraw, you may receive an "F"
grade.

Is attendance important? ABSOLUTELY!

-Students are expected to attend all class meetings (classroom or online) in courses which they are registered. Students enrolled in online courses MUST log onto their course within the first week of the semester. Failure to log into the online course can result in course access being denied by the instructor. Excessive absence or lateness may lead to a recommendation by the instructor that the student be dropped from the class with an appropriate grade. Instructors determine their own class attendance policy.
