- A graduate of a NYS high school with a 72-84 HS cumulative GPA (*If a student has a high school average that is higher than 84, but is in need of remediation courses, he/she may be eligible for EOP*)
- An economically disadvantaged student (see income guidelines)
- A transfer student previously enrolled in EOP/HEOP at former college

INCOME GUIDELINESS

The table below lists financial eligibility requirements for EOP admission for students entering the Fall 2021 - Spring 2022 academic year. Subsequent changes to these guidelines will be posted on the EOP Web site. In order to be determined economically disadvantaged, a student must be from a household in which the income does not exceed the amount shown for its size in the applicable category or must be in economic circumstances that conform to one of the exceptions listed below the income chart.

INCOME GUIDELINES DO NOT APPLY IF:

- The student's family is the recipient of Family Assistance or Safety Net payments through the New York State Office of Temporary and Disability Assistance; or through a county Department of Social Services; or Family Day Care payments through the New York State Office of Children and Family Assistance;
- The student is in foster care as established by the court;
- The student is a ward of the state or county.

Income Documents to Submit with Application

Before mailing your application, include the appropriate financial documentation listed below:

- Copy of your 1040 form if you worked last year and filed income taxes **OR**
- Form 4506T, as verification, if you did not file taxes or have filed no income **OR**
- Copy of last year's budget sheet or documentation indicating the social security benefits you received if you received public assistance or social security benefits **AND**
- Your parent's income documentation if you are under age 24 and do not have dependents (children) of your own **Please Note:** You must have a FAFSA on file with the Financial Aid Office to make your application complete. **Mail your application to:**
