CNC PRE-APPRENTICE PROGRAM

Inspired by the Uniquely Abled Project in CA, SUNY Ulster has been awarded grants funds to partner with The Arc Mid-Hudson to train in the high-demand field of CNC. Using lessons learned from the Uniquely Abled Project, SUNY Ulster's goal is to change the way the community thinks and talks about disabilities, specifically in regards to the autistic community and promote a more inclusive approach to education and employment.
