## DRIVER EDUCATION

The driver education training program, approved by the New York State Education Department, is a 48-hour course. Included are six hours of behind-the-wheel instruction, 18 hours of in-car observation and 24 hours of classroom training and orientation. To register, you must be at least 16 years of age at the time of orientation and possess a learner's permit. Driver Education Application/Consent Form is available at [sunyulster.edu/ce](http://sunyulster.edu/ce) which must be completed by a parent or guardian. Note: Driving time is finalized at the orientation. Missed classes must be made up at another high school. Permission is required.

## SCHOOL BUS DRIVER BASIC 30-HOUR COURSE

The School Bus Driver basic 30-hour course instructed by Drive On Guard's professional and influential instructors will be conducted this spring at SUNY Ulster. This course meets the regulations of the New York State Education Department which requires that each school bus driver completes a course of instruction in school bus safety practice with in the first year of employment. The New York State Education Department curriculum is followed and meets section 156.3 regulations. Participants are eligible for point and insurance reduction. Enrollees are awarded a Certificate of Completion by the State Education Department upon successful completion of all requirements and a 10% Point Insurance Reduction Certificate. (PIRP Certificate is only valid for 3 years.)

## MOTORCYCLE SAFETY MSF INTRODUCTORY MOTORCYCLE EXPERIENCE

The 2-hour Motorcycle Safety Foundation (MSF) Introductory Motorcycle Experience allows for classroom and practical training to either prepare for the MSF Basic RiderCourse or to see if motorcycling is for you. There is no driver's license or motorcycle permit requirement for this hands-on course that starts in the classroom and then transitions to the motorcycle.

## MSF BASIC RIDERCOURSE

Students who successfully complete this 18-hour course will receive the DMV Road Test Waiver! This class consists of a 3-hour online eCourse, 5 hours of classroom instruction and 10 hours of practical training on a motorcycle or scooter. The riding portion teaches skills such as straight-line riding, stopping, shifting, turning, swerving, and emergency braking. We provide everything that you will need to take the course -from motorcycles/scooters to helmets! Students must have a valid NYS Driver's License and NYS Motorcycle Permit at the time of waiver redemption (permit test may be taken after course completion). Additionally, be sure to check with your insurance company, as you may be eligible for discounts as a result of taking the course. **Course Cost is \$275.**



## MSF BASIC RIDERCOURSE 2—LICENSE WAIVER

Experienced riders who successfully complete this 8-hour course will receive the DMV License Waiver! The course curriculum includes a 3-hour on-line eCourse and 5 hours of practical training followed by a riding skills test. This alternative to the DMV Road Test is designed for experienced riders who have the ability to perform circles and figure eights on a motorcycle/scooter. Check with your insurance provider for eligible discounts!

**Course Cost is \$225.**

## MSF BASIC RIDERCOURSE 2

Refresh and fine-tune your safety skills! This 5-hour course is designed for BRC graduates or intermediate riders to practice slow-speed maneuvering while also working on cornering, swerving, and braking techniques. Students can use their own street-legal motorcycle/scooter or use one of our motorcycles free of charge. Passengers are allowed to accompany licensed riders only. Discounts are available for motorcycle clubs.

**Course cost is \$95, with group discounts available.**

## PRIVATE LESSONS

Enjoy personalized instruction at your own pace, and learn how to ride safely. Students will practice slow-speed maneuvers while under the guidance of a DMV-Certified Instructor. Private lessons are highly recommended for new riders to build confidence while familiarizing themselves with a motorcycle or scooter. **Lessons cost \$60 per hour or \$120 for 2 hours.**

The Ultimate Training Package allows a person who has never ridden a motorcycle or scooter to learn all the skills necessary to safely ride at an advanced level.
