UB DIGNITY FOR ALL STUDENTS ACT (DASA) WORKSHOP BLENDED FORMAT

This a six-hour training in Harassment, Bullying, Cyberbullying and Discrimination in Schools: Prevention and Intervention. New York State's Dignity Act seeks to provide the State's public elementary and secondary school students with a safe and supportive environment free from discrimination, intimidation, taunting, harassment, and bullying on school property, on a school bus and/or at a school function. School professionals applying for certification or licensing after December 31, 2013 are required to complete this course work. This workshop is in a blended learning format consisting of 3-hours of online training and 3-hours of in-person training. UB SECURITY GUARD

New York State requires the licensing of all security guards or personnel acting in security functions. Ulster BOCES is approved by the NYS Division of Criminal Justice Services to offer the mandated eight-hour pre-assignment training program.

REFUND Policy for Security Guard Program ONLY. Students will be entitled to a 100% refund at any time prior to the start of instruction. If an 8-hour course is divided between two 4-hour days, student will be entitled to a 50% refund if the student cancels after the start of instruction, but before the start of second 4-hour block.

A DCJS approved security guard training school cannot assess any non-refundable registration fees, deposits, or cancellation.
