

DRIVER EDUCATION



This 48-hour program is approved by the New York State Education Department. It includes six hours of behind-the-wheel instruction, 18 hours of in-car observation and 24 hours of classroom training and orientation. Students are assigned to drive one day a week and to attend lecture one day a week. This program is administered in cooperation with an area auto school.

Cost: \$579

Note: Your driving time will be given at orientation. Six to eight weeks after course completion, students will be mailed a Certificate of Completion which may allow a reduction in your insurance.

Required: You must be at least 16 years of age at the time of orientation and possess a learner's permit .

BY FAX: Fax your completed Registration /Consent Form to 845-331-2331, 24 hours a day, 7 days a week.

Registration is NOT complete until you are registered and a completed Consent Form (see other side) has been received.

Note: Class dates may change due to inclement weather and school district schedule changes such as closings and early dismissals. Classes that meet less than 16 sessions will require make-up time, arranged by the instructor. Missed classes must be made up at another high school.
