This driver training course is approved by the NYS Education Department Traffic Safety Unit and The New York State Department of Motor Vehicles. The 48-hour course includes:

- ★ 24 hours of in-car instruction including 6 hours behind-the-wheel instruction and 18 hours of in-car observation time
- ★ 24 hours of classroom instruction

Students are assigned to drive one day a week and to attend lecture one day a week. Upon completion, students will receive a certificate, which may allow a reduction in your insurance. This program is administered in cooperation with an area auto school.
