AID FOR PART-TIME STUDY is a New York State financial aid program for part-time study students. Part-time is defined as those students who are taking at least three but less than twelve college credits (OTP courses, Express Semester courses, and/or module courses *do not* count towards APTS course load).

The eligibility criteria must be met in order for a student to be eligible. The *check list below* will assist you in determining your eligibility for this grant. To guarantee a timely review of all applications, our deadlines for meeting all eligibility criteria are as follows:

Semester	Deadline Date
Fall 2022	Friday, August 5, 2022
Spring 2023	Friday, January 6, 2023

Students who fail to meet *all* of the eligibility criteria or documentation requirements by the deadline date will not be considered for an award for that semester.

Eligibility Requirements for APTS

- □ Matriculated in a program of study;
- □ Enrolled for at least 3, but less than 12 college credits (excluding OTP, Express semester and/or module classes lasting less than 15 weeks) that apply towards your declared program of study;
- □ Maintained Good Academic Standing per New York State requirements;
- □ Maintained 2.0 GPA and have no more than 1 Audit, Unsatisfactory, Withdrawal, or Noncompletion grade for every 30 credits attempted (10%);
- □ Have remaining TAP undergraduate points available;
- □ Not in default on a Federal Student Loan;
- □ Submitted signed copies of student/spouse 2019 NYS Tax return---this is required from all students/spouses who filed a tax return;
- □ Submitted a signed copy of student's parents 2019 NYS Tax return---this is required from all students who were claimed by either parent.

NOTE: Students taking at least 3 credits may be eligible for a 2022-2023 Federal Pell Grant. To apply, complete the 2022-2023 FAFSA Application at <u>www.studentaid.gov</u>. Unlike APTS – the Federal Pell Grant includes OTP classes.
